1. Paste or draw a picture of yourself and write your name on the front cover of your journal.
2. Use the picture sheets to learn about items you would find in a West African village or marketplace. Cut out the pictures and paste them into the journal pages using a glue stick.
3. Imagine that you are visiting a West African village like the one in *The Heart of the Lion*. What would you see? Who would you meet? What are the tastes, smells and sounds of the village? Write your own journal entry using the pictures as your guide.
4. You can draw or collect other pictures of West Africa and use them in your journal. Punch three holes in the top of each additional page.
5. Fasten your journal together using sting, leather or yarn.
